Healesville artist Christine Cafarella-Pearce paints with a distinctive technique, pallet, and sense of design. Inspired by The Heidelberg School and the French Impressionists, Christine enjoys artistic challenges and new projects are an integral part of her artistic development. A multi award winning Artist Christine is passionate about supporting her local art community whenever she can. She has been an art mentor at Healesville Primary School and generously supports up and coming artists wherever she can.

Christine studied portraiture and still life under the tuition of Lee Machelak, but found the method allowed little space for creativity and imaginative interpretation of a subject. Today, her works are underpinned by observation and tonal values to give her paintings body and a sense of power. She has found her own way to tell her story in paint. Her portraits go far beyond pure technique and workmanship as she uses her expertise to expresses her sitter's character with love and positive sensitivity.

Christine is a keen landscape painter, painting in response to seasons, events, and the environment. She involves her viewers by creating emotional connections between themselves and her work, leading them through her story with compositional values, tone, colour, line, and shape.

Christine sometimes expresses her views on social injustices in paint, building her work in such a way that the viewer is encouraged to dwell on the positives in this world whilst inspiring them to love people just as they are. Christine sometimes writes poetry to express her paintings and feelings and sometimes paints to further express her poetry. She would say, "My faith has shown me a different way- to see how often we lack respect, love and caring for people and how we sometimes prefer to consider our own rights above others".

Biography

Christine was born in 1952 to Italian parents and lived in Montrose, Victoria. Married 1972 she and husband Chris became self-employed sharing work responsibilities. This decision allowed them the flexibility they needed to education and care for their four children whilst enabling Christine to pursue her art career. She is thankful that her painting life links seamlessly with home, family, work, and travel. In 2001 Christine moved to Healesville and discovered a new level of contentment painting the diversity of the valley landscapes framed by beautiful blue mountains. Christine supports her church community and is a willing worker and friend of the Healesville Lions Club and the local community.
